IRB APPLICATION & PROTOCOL NARRATIVE

- Describes consent process for non-English speakers
- · Identifies languages likely to be encountered
- Includes consent materials:
 - English version only
 - o Written at 8th grade level or lower
 - \circ Submitted with the application

IRB REVIEW

- If needed, the IRB requests changes to the English version consent materials.
- Researcher revises English version and resubmits with response.

IRB-APPROVAL

• Approval letter identifies IRB-approved consent requirements and indicates if short form consent is approved.

TRANSLATIONS

- Researcher obtains accurate written translations of the IRBapproved English version consent and any recruitment materials.
- Researcher submits translated consent materials (including any recruitment materials) to the IRB for approval <u>before</u> enrolling subjects using the translated consent form and recruitment materials (as described in the "<u>preferred</u> method").
